1.) SANTA ROSA JUNIOR COLLEGE

COMPLETE TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

Begin by completing the requirements to transfer to Sonoma State's Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies program at Santa Rosa Junior College (SRJC). Requirements to be accepted into the SSU BA of Liberal Studies are to complete 60 transferrable units that include the California State University (CSU) 39-unit General Education Pattern, and maintain an overall grade point average of a 'C' or better. The recommended common General Education courses that will fulfill subject matter requirements can be found on www.assist.org and on the SRJC Transfer Center web site at <http://www.santarosa.edu/app/counseling/transfer/multsubj-sonoma.pdf>. Another option is to complete the Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer degree.

You MUST take CHILD 10 and HIST 17.1 or POLS 1 to fulfill Dominican University of California's prerequisites.

Students planning to transfer should plan their programs using the Sonoma State University catalog and the assistance of a Santa Rosa Junior College counselor.
